Aircraft Accident

On January 31, 2000, Alaska Airlines flight 261 from Puerto Vallarta enroute to San Francisco, went down in the water off the coast of California near Point Mugu. The flight carried 83 passengers and five crew members. There were no survivors. Consistent with industry standards, the Company maintains insurance against aircraft accidents. Any aircraft accident, even if fully insured, could cause a negative public perception of the Company with adverse financial consequences. However, the Company believes this accident will not result in a material adverse impact on the financial position or results of operations of the Company.
